**INTERPRETATION AND GENERAL CLAUSES ACT**

**SOLVENT EMISSIONS ACT 2002 (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS  
2010**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 23(g)(ii) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Act, and all other enabling powers, and in order to partly transpose into the law of Gibraltar Directive 2008/112/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 December 2008 amending Council Directives 76/768/EEC, 88/378/EEC, 1999/13/EC and Directives 2000/53/EC, 2002/96/EC and 2004/42/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council in order to adapt them to Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008 on classification, labelling and packaging of substances and mixtures, the Government has made the following Regulations—

**Title and commencement.**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Solvent Emissions Act 2002 (Amendment) Regulations 2010 and come into operation on the day of publication.

**Interpretation.**

2. In these Regulations “the principal Act” means the Solvent Emissions Act 2002.

**Amendment of section 2.**

3. In section 2 of the principal Act at the end of the definition “the Directive” insert the words “; as the same may be amended from time to time”.

**Amendment of Schedule 1.**

4. In Schedule 1 to the principal Act for the paragraph heading “Manufacturing of coating preparations, varnishes, inks and adhesives.”

substitute the paragraph heading “Manufacturing of coating mixtures, varnishes, inks and adhesives.”.

**Amendment of Schedule 2.**

5. In the table in Schedule 2 to the principal Act—

- (a) in entry numbered 17 for the words “preparations” and “preparation” substitute “mixtures” and “mixture” respectively;
- (b) in the entry numbered 18 for the word “preparations” substitute “mixtures”; and
- (c) in the entry numbered 20 for the word “preparations” substitute “mixtures”.

**Amendment of Schedule 3.**

6. Schedule 3 to the principal Act is amended—

- (a) in paragraph 6, on both occasions the word “preparations” appears substitute the word “mixtures”; and
- (b) in paragraph 8—
  - (i) by substituting for the words “the risk phrase R40” the words “the risk phrases R40 or R68”; and
  - (ii) by inserting after the words “the labelling R40” the words “or R68”.
