AN ACT to amend the Trade Licensing Act.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title and commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Trade Licensing (Amendment) Act 2012 and comes into operation on the day of publication.

Amendments to the Trade Licensing Act.

2. The Trade Licensing Act is amended—

- (a) in section 2(1) in the definition “appropriate fee” for “Governor” substitute “Government”;
- (b) in section 7(2)(a) by deleting “or”;
- (c) in section 7(2)(b) by substituting “.” with “;” ;
- (d) after section 7(2)(b) insert the following—
 - “(c) the transferor has left or proposes to leave the premises while owing, to the Government, rent, rates, social insurance payments, duties or taxes and the transferee has made no proposal for settlement of the amounts owing; or
 - (d) the transferor has been charged with an offence in respect of one or more goods covered by the licence.”;
- (e) in sections 16(3) and 24(1) for “Governor” substitute “Government”;
- (f) by substituting section 26(1) as follows—

“26.(1) There is hereby established a Trade Licensing Authority which shall consist of the Chairman and eight other members appointed by the Government, two of whom shall be appointed after consultation with the Gibraltar Chamber of Commerce, two after consultation with the Gibraltar Trades Council and two after consultation with the Gibraltar Federation of Small Businesses.” ;

(g) in section 28(1) for “Governor” substitute “Government”.

Passed by the Gibraltar Parliament on the 16th day of November, 2012.
