 \boldsymbol{AN} \boldsymbol{ACT} to amend the Trade Unions and Trade Disputes Act and to ensure compliance with Article 8 of Regulation (EEC) No 1612/68 of the Council of 15 October 1968 on freedom of movement for workers within the Community.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title and Commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Trade Unions and Trade Disputes (Amendment) Act 2006 and comes into operation on the date appointed by the Minister by Notice in the Gazette.

Amendments to the Trade Unions and Trade Disputes Act.

- 2. The Trade Unions and Trade Disputes Act is amended as follows-
 - (a) in section 2 before the definition of "trade union" insert-
 - ""Minister" means Minister with responsibility for employment;";
 - (b) in section 5, for "Subject to the provisions of section 8, any", substitute "Any";
 - (c) delete section 8;
 - (d) in section 18(a), for "wife" substitute "spouse";
 - (e) in section 21 insert, after subsection (2)-
 - "(3) Nothing in this section shall affect the liability of a trade union or any official thereof to be sued under the Equal Opportunities Act 2006."; and
 - (f) in sections 3, 13, 25, 30, 31, 32 and 33, each time it appears, for "Governor" substitute "Minister".
