**TRAFFIC ACT 2005**

**TRAFFIC (LICENSING AND REGISTRATION) (AMENDMENT)  
REGULATIONS 2011**

In exercise of the powers under sections 57 and 89 of the Traffic Act 2005, and all other enabling powers, the Minister has made the following regulations—

**Title.**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Vehicles (Licensing and Registration) (Amendment) Regulations 2011.

**Amendments to the Traffic (Licensing and Registration) Regulations.**

2. Regulation 68 of the Traffic (Licensing and Registration) Regulations is amended by—

- (a) deleting “other than motorcycles” in the title;
- (b) deleting “other than motorcycles” in subregulation (1); and
- (c) substituting “20 metres” for “23 metres” in subregulation (1)(a).

**EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

These regulations provide for the distance at which a registration plate can be read in order to pass a driving test (for all vehicles) to be reduced to 20 metres.
