**TRAFFIC ACT 2005**

**TRAFFIC (LICENSING AND REGISTRATION) (AMENDMENT)  
REGULATIONS 2012**

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 57 and 101 of the Traffic Act 2005, and all other enabling powers, the Government has made the following regulations—

**Title and commencement.**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Licensing and Registration) (Amendment) Regulations 2012 and come into operation on the day of publication.

**Amendments to the Traffic (Licensing and Registration) Regulations.**

2.(1) The Traffic (Licensing and Registration) Regulations are amended in accordance with this regulation.

(2) In regulation 72(4) for “one month” substitute “14 days”.

(3) In paragraph 7.1 of Schedule 4B for “oral examination. It shall test the applicant has the required knowledge” substitute “an examination in such manner as the Minister may direct of the applicant’s knowledge”.

**EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

These Regulations provide that—

- (1) a person who has failed a driving test may apply for a further test within 14 days of the date of failure, as opposed to one month;
- (2) the theoretical test may be in the manner directed by the Minister as opposed to being limited to oral examinations only.
