TRAFFIC ACT 2005

TRAFFIC (LICENSING AND REGISTRATION) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2013

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 57 and 101 of the Traffic Act 2005, and all other enabling powers, the Government has made the following Regulations—

Title and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Licensing and Registration) (Amendment) Regulations 2013 and come into operation on 1 September 2013.

Amendment to Traffic (Licensing and Registration) Regulations.

2. The Traffic (Licensing and Registration) Regulations are amended in accordance with the provisions of these Regulations.

Amendment to regulation 2.

3. In regulation 2 after the definition "British Forces (B.F.G.) driving licence" insert the following definitions-

""CBT certificate" means a certificate issued under the Traffic (Compulsory Basic Test) Regulations 2013;

"Compulsory Basic Training Course" has the meaning given to it by regulation 3 of the Traffic (Compulsory Basic Test) Regulations 2013;".

Amendment to regulation 84.

- 4. In regulation 84-
 - (a) in subregulation (3) for "." substitute ";"; and

- (b) after subregulation (3) insert the following subregulation—
 - "(4) This regulation does not apply to a motor vehicle in category AM, A1 and A2.";

Amendment to Schedule 1.

- 5. In Schedule 1-
 - (a) in Form 21 for "A" Motor Cycles, Invalid Carriages, Three wheeled motor vehicles." substitute "Invalid Carriages";
 - (b) after Form 21 in Schedule 1 insert-
