TRAFFIC ACT.

**VEHICLES (CONSTRUCTION, EQUIPMENT AND MAINTENANCE)
(AMENDMENT) (NO. 5) REGULATIONS, 1986.**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 44 of the Traffic Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following regulations:

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Vehicles (Construction, Equipment and Maintenance) (Amendment) (No. 5) Regulations, 1986.

Revocation of Regulation 25.

2. The Vehicles (Construction, Equipment and Maintenance) Regulations is amended by revoking regulation 25 thereof and substituting therefor the following new regulation:

"25. All glass or other transparent material fitted to motor vehicles shall be maintained in such a condition that it does not obscure the vision of the driver while the vehicle is being driven on a road or obscure the driver from the vision of any person looking from the outside of the motor vehicle into the interior of the motor vehicle while it is either stationary or being driven on a road."
