**TRAFFIC ACT.**

**VEHICLES (CONSTRUCTION, EQUIPMENT AND  
MAINTENANCE) (AMENDMENT) (NO.2) REGULATIONS, 1987**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 44 of the Traffic Act, and by all other enabling powers, I hereby make the following regulations-

**Title.**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Vehicles (Construction, Equipment and Maintenance) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1987.

**New regulation.**

2. The Vehicles (Construction, Equipment and Maintenance) Regulations, (hereinafter called "the principal regulations") are amended by inserting after regulation 3 the following new regulation-

**"Offences.**

3A. A person in control of a vehicles who contravenes or fails to comply with any of the provisions of these regulations, or causes or permits or suffers any vehicle to be used in contravention of these regulations is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of 100."

**Regulation 84 revoked.**

3. Regulation 84 of the principal regulations together with the headnote "Penalties" are revoked.
