## TRAFFIC ACT 2005

## TRAFFIC (MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENT NO. 2) REGULATIONS 2022

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 57 and 89 of the Traffic Act 2005, and all other enabling powers, the Government has made the following Regulations-

#### Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Miscellaneous Amendment No.2) Regulations 2022.

#### Commencement.

2. These Regulations come into operation on the day of publication.

## Amendment to the Control of Traffic Regulations.

3. In regulation 32(4) of the Control of Traffic Regulations for "level 1" substitute "level 3".

#### Amendment to the Traffic (Traffic Lights) Regulations, 1986.

4. In regulation 6 of the Traffic (Traffic Lights) Regulations, 1986 for "level 1" substitute "level 3".

#### Amendment to the Traffic (Pelican Pedestrian Crossings) Regulations, 1986.

5. In regulation 11 of the Traffic (Pelican Pedestrian Crossings) Regulations, 1986 for "of £50.00" substitute "at level 3 on the standard scale".

#### Amendment to the Vehicles (Construction, Equipment and Maintenance) Regulations.

6. In regulation 3A of the Vehicles (Construction, Equipment and Maintenance) Regulations for "of £100" substitute "at level 3 on the standard scale".
