Title.

1.(1) This notice may be cited as the Traffic (Parking Fees) Notice, 1984.

Interpretation.

2. in this notice-

"period" includes any lesser period falling within the period specified.

Parking Charges.

3. A parking charge shall be paid for the parking of every motor vehicle at any car park specified in the Schedule, at the rate specified in the Schedule in relation to that car park.

Payment of fees.

4. Where fees are collected in a car park specified in Part 1 of the Schedule by mechanical means, the person in charge of the vehicle shall cause the parking ticket issued by the machine to be affixed in a prominent position on the inside of the windscreen of the vehicle in such position as to enable the parking ticket to be read from outside the vehicle by a person with normal eyesight.

Meters

- 5. (1) Where in a car park listed in Part 2 of the Schedule there is a meter in operation in respect of the bay in which a motor vehicle is parked—
 - (a) a person in charge of a motor vehicle so parked shall cause the prescribed fee to be inserted in such meter;
 - (b) it shall be an offence to insert in such meter coins additional to those inserted by way of payment of the prescribed fee;
 - (c) the indications given by such meter shall be conclusive evidence of compliance or otherwise with the requirements for the payment of fees specified in the Schedule.
- (2) A person who, with intent to defraud, interferes with the parking meter, or operates or attempts to operate a parking meter by the insertion of objects other than current coins in the appropriate denomination, shall be guilty of an offence.

- 6. It shall be an offence for a person in charge of a motor vehicle-
 - (a) which is or has been parked in a car park specified in Part 1 of the Schedule–
 - (i) and fails to produce, on being requested to do so by an authorised person, a parking ticket showing the period during which the motor vehicle was so parked;
 - (ii) and to which paragraph 4 applies to fail to comply with the requirements of paragraph 4;
 - (b) to fail to remove that motor vehicle from a car park specified in Part 2 of the Schedule upon the expiry of the period in respect of which the prescribed fee has been inserted in the meter in accordance with paragraph 5.
