**MOTOR VEHICLE TEST REGULATIONS 1987 (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 1997**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 4B and 4C of the Traffic Act and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following Regulations –

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicle Test Regulations 1987 (Amendment) Regulations 1997.

Amendments to the Motor Vehicle Test Regulations 1987

2.(1) The Motor Vehicle Test Regulations 1987 shall be amended as provided for in this section.

(2) The term “test certificate” wherever it appears, shall be substituted by the term “roadworthiness certificate”: without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, the term “test certificate” shall be substituted by “roadworthiness certificate” in the following provisions –

- (a) regulation 2 (in the definition of “re-examination” and of “test certificate”);
- (b) regulation 7;
- (c) regulation 10(c);
- (d) regulation 16(1) and (2);
- (e) regulation 17;

- (f) regulation 18(2);
- (g) the heading “Re-examination after refusal of test-certificate” after regulation 18;
- (h) regulation 19(1);
- (i) regulation 20(1);
- (j) regulation 21(4);
- (k) regulation 22(1) and (2);
- (l) regulation 23(1)(a);
- (m) regulation 24(a), (b) and (c);
- (n) regulation 30(1);
- (o) regulation 35;
- (p) regulation 36;
- (q) regulation 37;
- (r) regulation 38;
- (s) regulation 40;
- (t) regulation 44(a);
- (u) regulation 46(b);
- (v) in the following provisions of Schedule 4 –
 - (i) Form MVT/4;
 - (ii) Form MVT/5;
 - (iii) Form MVT/6;

(iv) Form MVT/7; and

(v) Form MVT/8.

(3) Regulation 37 shall be amended as follows –

(a) by substituting for sub-regulation (1) and (2) the following sub-regulation –

“(1) Subject to sub-regulation (2), a roadworthiness certificate issued in respect of a motor vehicle or trailer shall be valid for a period therein not exceeding 12 months from the date of issue.”;

(b) by renumbering sub-regulations “(3)” and “(4)”, “(2)” and “(3)” respectively.

(c) by substituting for the reference “3” in sub-regulation (3), the reference “2”.

(4) Schedule 5 (Fees) shall be amended as follows –

(a) for paragraphs (1) and (2), there shall be substituted the following paragraphs –

“(1) On application for the examination of a motor vehicle or trailer which is –

(a) a private motor vehicle £15,

(b) a motor cycle £10,

(c) a public service vehicle with seating capacity for more than 8 passengers £30,

(d) a public service vehicle with seating for not more than 8 passengers £15,

(e) a goods vehicle the unladen weight of which exceeds

| (2) | On application for the examination of a trailer | £15.”; |
| (b) | for paragraph 6, there shall be substituted the following paragraph – | |
| | “6. For re-examination of a vehicle under regulation 23 | £13.”; |
| (c) | for paragraph 8, there shall be substituted the following paragraph – | |
| | “8. For the issue of a duplicate roadworthiness certificate | £5.”. |
