Title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Road Traffic (Windscreen Transparency) Act 1998 (Amendment) Act 1999.

## Amendment to the Road Traffic (Windscreen Transparency) Act 1998.

2. For section 2 there shall be substituted the following section -

## "Driving with improper windscreen or windows.

- 2.(1) Subject to subsections (2) and (3), a person who uses on a road a motor vehicle or trailer registered in Gibraltar which is equipped with a windscreen or other window which contravenes the conditions set out in section 3 or causes or permits such a motor vehicle or trailer to be so used, shall commit an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.
- (2) The Minister may, on the recommendation of the Chief Motor Vehicle Examiner, issue a certificate exempting from sub-section (1) -
- (a) a particular motor vehicle or trailer with an arrangement of windows, or
- (b) all motor vehicles or trailers conforming to a specified make and model, which is certified by the manufacturer as only sold with as arrangement of windows,

which the Minister is satisfied is sufficiently transparent to enable an outside observer with reasonable eyesight to see the occupants clearly enough to be able to recognise them later.

(3) In this section, "Minister" means the Minister with responsibility for transport.".
