TRAFFIC ACT 2005

**TRAFFIC (PEDESTRIANISATION) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 2018**

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 89 of the Traffic Act 2005 and all other enabling powers, the Government has made the following Regulations—

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Pedestrianisation) (Amendment) Regulations 2018.

Commencement.

2. These Regulations come into operation on 6 August 2018.

Amendment of the Traffic (Pedestrianisation) Regulations 2001.

3.(1) The Traffic (Pedestrianisation) Regulations 2001 are amended in accordance with the provisions of this regulation.

(2) In regulation 2, in the definition of “vehicle”, delete “and bicycles”.

(3) In regulation 4(a), after “vehicles” insert “and bicycles”.

(4) After regulation 5(1), insert—

“(1ZA) It shall be an offence for any person to ride or park a bicycle in a Pedestrianised Area in breach of an order under these Regulations.”.

(5) In regulation 7—

(a) delete “motor” in every instance in which it appears; and

(b) after every instance in which “vehicles” appears insert “and bicycles”.
