## TRAFFIC ACT 2005

### TRAFFIC (PEDESTRIANISATION) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by regulation 89 of the Act, and all other enabling powers, the Government has made the following Regulations—

#### **Title.**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Pedestrianisation) (Amendment) Regulations 2023.

#### **Commencement.**

2. These Regulations come into operation on the day of publication.

#### **Amendment to the Traffic (Pedestrianisation) Regulations 2001.**

3.(1) The Traffic (Pedestrianisation) Regulations 2001 are amended in accordance with this regulation.

(2) In regulation 2, insert the following definitions before the definition of “Minister”—

““bicycle” does not include a cargo bicycle;”;

““cargo bicycle” means a bicycle that has two or more wheels that has been designed and constructed for the purposes of carrying a load but a bicycle that has been altered after it has been manufactured so that a box or other container is attached to it, whether permanently or otherwise, is not a cargo bicycle for the purposes of these Regulations;”.

(3) In regulation 4—

(a) in paragraph (a), after “motor vehicles,” insert “cargo bicycles,”; and

(b) in paragraph (b)—

(i) after “motor vehicles,” insert “cargo bicycles,”; and

(ii) for “is” substitute “are”.

- (4) In regulation 5, in subregulation (1), after “motor vehicle” insert “or cargo bicycle”.
- (5) In regulation 6, in subregulation (2), delete “motor” in every instance that it appears.
- (6) In regulation 7–
- (a) in subregulation (1), after “motor vehicles,” insert “cargo bicycles,”; and
  - (b) in subregulation (2), after “motor vehicles,” insert “cargo bicycles,”.
- (7) In the Schedule, insert the following entry below the entry for “Commercial Ad Hoc Permit”–
