TRAFFIC (PEDESTRIANISATION) REGULATIONS 2001

TRAFFIC (DESIGNATION OF PEDESTRIANISED AREAS) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by regulation 3 of the Traffic (Pedestrianisation) Regulations 2001, the Minister has made the following Order—

Title.

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic (Designation of Pedestrianised Areas) (Amendment) Order 2020.

Commencement.

2. This Order comes into operation on 31 May 2020.

Amendment to the Traffic (Designation of Pedestrianised Areas) Order 2001.

3.(1) The Traffic (Designation of Pedestrianised Areas) Order 2001 is amended in accordance with this paragraph.

(2) In paragraph 2—

- (a) in subparagraph (g), delete “(except for bicycles travelling from Grand Casemates Gates up to the entrance of Main Street)”;
- (b) in subparagraph (h), delete “(except for bicycles travelling from the junction of Main Street and George’s Lane towards Secretary’s Lane)”;
- (c) in subparagraph (m), delete “(except for bicycles travelling from Irish Town to the archway entrance to Cooperage Lane)”;
- (d) in subparagraph (n), delete “and bicycles”;
- (e) in subparagraph (p), delete “(except for bicycles travelling from John Mackintosh Square junction to Cooperage Lane junction)”;

(f) in subparagraph (q), delete “(except for bicycles travelling from the junction at 5 John Mackintosh Square to the junction of John Mackintosh Square and Irish Town)”; and

(g) in subparagraph (u), delete “(except for bicycles travelling from Casemates Square to Cathedral Square junction)”.

(3) For paragraph 4, substitute the following–

“4. No person may ride or park a bicycle in a Pedestrianised Area.”
