TRAFFIC (PEDESTRIANISATION) REGULATIONS 2001

TRAFFIC (DESIGNATION OF PEDESTRIANISED AREAS) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by regulation 3 of the Traffic (Pedestrianisation) Regulations 2001, the Minister has made the following Order—

Title.

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic (Designation of Pedestrianised Areas) (Amendment) Order 2023.

Commencement.

2. This Order comes into operation on the day of publication.

Amendment to the Traffic (Designation of Pedestrianised Areas) Order 2001.

3.(1) The Traffic (Designation of Pedestrianised Areas) Order 2001 is amended in accordance with this Article.

(2) Substitute Article 3 with the following—

“3. No person may—

- (a) drive, park or be in charge of a motor vehicle; or
- (b) ride a cargo bicycle;

in a Pedestrianised Area unless it is permitted under Article 2 or 4(2) or it is being done in connection with a permit issued under regulation 6 of the Traffic (Pedestrianisation) Regulations 2011.”

(3) Article 4 is renumbered as Article 4(1).

(4) In renumbered Article 4(1) after “Pedestrianised Area” insert “except as provided for in paragraph (2)”.

(5) After Article 4(1) insert-

“(2) Article 2(n), (h), (p) and (q) do not apply to bicycles or cargo bicycles that are ridden-

- (a) along George’s Lane towards Main Street and along Cathedral Square towards the junction with Secretary’s Lane (by Fortress House);
- (b) from the junction of Cathedral Square and Bomb House Lane, along Cathedral Square towards the junction with Secretary’s Lane (by Fortress House); or
- (c) from the junction by 17 John Mackintosh Square towards the junction of Irish Town and Mackintosh Square, to the junction of Irish Town and Cloister Ramp and exiting via Cloister Ramp.”.
