SCHEDULE

DESCRIPTION OF THE OFFENCE ENACTMENT

- 1. Leaving a vehicle unattended and not drawn Control of Traffic up to the right hand side of the road so as to Regulations, permit the maximum clear passage for Regulation 8(a) passing traffic.
- 2. Causing a vehicle or trailer to cause Regulation 17 unnecessary obstruction of a road or obstruct the passage of traffic.
- 3. Stopping a vehicle or part thereof within the Regulation 50 limits of a pedestrian crossing.
