### TRAFFIC (FIXED PENALTY OFFENCE) NOTICE

#### SCHEDULE

DESCRIPTION OF THE OFFENCE	ENACTMENT
1. Leaving a vehicle unattended and not drawn up to the right hand side of the road so as to permit the maximum clear passage for passing traffic.	Control of Traffic Regulations, Regulation 8(a)
2. Causing a vehicle or trailer to cause unnecessary obstruction of a road or obstruct the passage of traffic.	Regulation 17
3. Stopping a vehicle or part thereof within the limits of a pedestrian crossing.	Regulation 50
4. Parking a vehicle upon a footpath or at a place where parking is prohibited by traffic signs.	Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Order, Paragraph 3
5. Waiting with or parking a vehicle at an appointed bus stop.	Paragraph 6
6. Waiting with or parking a vehicle at an appointed taxi stand.	Paragraph 7
7. Parking a vehicle in a space reserved for Police, Hospital Service or Prison vehicles.	Paragraph 9, 10, 11 or 12
8. Parking a vehicle in a car park other than inside the areas demarcated with paint.	Paragraph 14.
9. Waiting with or parking a vehicle at a place where waiting is prohibited by traffic signs.	Paragraph 17.
10. Waiting with or parking a vehicle at places demarcated with yellow paint or by traffic signs except for loading or unloading goods.	Paragraph 18.
11. Stopping a vehicle or part thereof within the limits of a "pelican" crossing.	Traffic (Pelican Pedestrian Crossings) Regulations 1986, Regulation 10(1)
12. Parking a vehicle at any place or location within the City Centre.	Traffic (City Centre) Parking Restriction Order, 1986,

## TRAFFIC (FIXED PENALTY OFFENCE) NOTICE Paragraph 4.

- 13 Neglecting to pay the authorised parking fee or causing or permitting a vehicle to remain in a parking place after the expiry of the period for which payment of the fee authorises parking. Traffic Ordinance section 95(5)
- 14 Driving or parking on a road within a Pedestrianised zone established under the Traffic (Pedestrianisation) Regulations 2001, without displaying a permit other than in accordance with the terms of a valid permit. Traffic (Pedestrianisation) Regulations 2001, Regulation 5

### **Revocation.**

3. The Traffic (Fixed Penalty Offences) Notice 1988 is revoked.
