ABANDONED VEHICLES (REMOVAL) REGULATIONS 2004

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Abandoned Vehicles (Removal) Regulations 2004.

Removal and disposal of abandoned vehicles.

2.(1) Where a vehicle appears to have been abandoned on a road, parking place or other place to which the public have access on payment of a fee or otherwise, a police officer or other person or persons authorised by the Minister for Transport may—

- (a) remove it to a place of safe custody designated by the Government; or
- (b) affix a notice to the vehicle stating—
 - (i) that the vehicle appears to have been abandoned;
 - (ii) that the vehicle will be disposed of or removed to a place designated by the Government after 14 days unless removed by the owner.

(2) The Government shall publish on at least two separate occasions in a newspaper circulating in Gibraltar on a daily basis (excluding Sundays) any vehicle removed or to which a notice has been affixed under sub-regulation (1) specifying a brief description of the vehicle, its location and (if known, or readily ascertainable) the name of the registered owner and registration number of the vehicle.

(3) Where—

- (a) a vehicle is removed under sub-regulation (1)(a) and is not reclaimed by its registered owner within a period of 14 days from the date of the second publication referred to in sub-regulation (2) above; or
- (b) a vehicle to which the notice was affixed under sub-regulation (1)(b) has not been removed within 14 days of the date of second publication referred to in sub-regulation (2),

the Government shall publish a notice in the Gazette stating its intention to dispose of the vehicle and may do so after the expiration of 7 days from the publication of the notice unless the owner of the vehicle or person acting on his behalf reclaims the vehicle and pays all charges specified.

ABANDONED VEHICLES (REMOVAL) REGULATIONS 2004

(4) The Minister for Transport may, by notice in the Gazette, specify the charges to be paid by the owner of a vehicle upon claiming and removing it from the custody of the Government.

(5) A vehicle shall be deemed to be abandoned under sub-regulation (1) if—

- (a) from its appearance, it appears not to be fit to be used or driven in compliance with the Traffic Act and regulations made thereunder; or
- (b) from its appearance, it appears to be derelict or abandoned; or
- (c) it appears to have remained immobile in the same location for a period of not less than 30 days.
