*In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph 12B and 12C of the Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Order, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister with responsibility for Transport has made the following Notice:*

**Title.**

1. This Notice may be cited as the Designation of Parking Spaces on Sir Herbert Miles Road Notice 2010.

**Designation under paragraph 12B.**

2. The car park opposite the former sand quarry site on Sir Herbert Miles Road, as shown outlined in red in the plan attached, is designated as an area to which paragraph 12B of the Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Order applies.

**Parking spaces on Sir Herbert Miles Road.**

3.(1) The parking spaces delineated by markings on the ground in the area referred to in paragraph 2 of this Notice are designated as spaces to which paragraph 12C of the Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Order applies.

(2) Only those cars issued with a valid parking permit may park in the designated spaces.

(3) A permit may be issued by the Minister and shall be valid for one year from the date of issue and may be renewed each year.

(4) A permit is not transferable and if the owner of the car to which the permit was issued is no longer a resident of Both Worlds or sells or otherwise disposes of the car the permit must be returned to the Minister.

(5) The Minister may issue a replacement permit, valid for the remainder of the term of the original permit, if the owner of the car replaces it with another car.

(6) The Minister may issue a replacement permit, valid for the remainder of the term of the original permit, if the original permit is lost or defaced.
