TRAFFIC ACT 2005

**TRAFFIC (PARKING AND WAITING) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 2012**

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 89, 91 and 101 of the Traffic Act 2005, the Government has made the following Regulations—

Title and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Parking and Waiting) (Amendment) Regulations 2012.

Amendment of Regulations.

2. The Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Regulations 2011 are amended by inserting the following regulation after regulation 4—

“Parking in a Bus Stop - Certificate of exemption.

4A.(1) The Minister may—

(a) for the purpose of enabling the use of bus stops by buses used for the conveyance of school children or disabled persons (or both), and

(b) on the recommendation of the Chief Examiner,

issue a certificate exempting a vehicle (or class of vehicles) from the prohibition imposed by regulation 4(1).

(2) A certificate issued pursuant to subregulation (1) may provide for such restrictions or conditions as the Minister thinks fit.

(3) A certificate issued under subregulation (1) shall be displayed on a vehicle while it is parked in a bus stop.”.
