**TRAFFIC ACT 2005**

**TRAFFIC (PARKING AND WAITING) (AMENDMENT No. 3)  
REGULATIONS 2013**

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 89, 91 and 101 of the Traffic Act 2005, the Government has made the following Regulations—

**Title and commencement.**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Parking and Waiting) (Amendment No. 3) Regulations 2013 and come into operation on the day of publication.

**Amendment to the Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Regulations 2011.**

2.(1) The Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Regulations 2011 are amended in accordance with this regulation.

(2) In regulation 17—

(a) in sub-regulation (1) after “Schedule 2” insert “and with blue paint on the ground”;

(b) after sub-regulation (1) insert the following sub-regulation—

“(1A) The maximum period a vehicle may park within the Pay and Display Zone—

(a) may be contained as additional information in the signs set out in Schedule 2; or

(b) shall be indicated by a traffic sign in such form as the Minister may approve from time to time where it is not contained in the signs set out in Schedule 2.”.

(3) For regulation 21 substitute—

- “(1) The parking fee prescribed under the Act shall be payable in respect of parking between such hours and on such days as the Minister may by Order specify.
- (2) An Order under sub-regulation (1) may specify different hours and days for different Zones.”.
- (4) For regulation 22 substitute-
- “(1) No person shall park a vehicle in a Pay and Display Zone for any continuous period exceeding any period specified by traffic signs in relation to that Zone.
- (2) The period set out under sub-regulation (1) shall not exceed five hours.”.
- (4) For Schedule 2 substitute-

**“SCHEDULE 2**

Regulation 17

**PAY AND DISPLAY**

Clockwise, the first sign below indicates that the area to which it relates is a controlled zone. Pay parking is available but only within the demarcated areas.

The second and third signs below indicate that the area to which they relate is a pay and display area and payment must be made at the pay and display machines.
