TRAFFIC (PARKING AND WAITING) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) REGULATIONS 2017

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 89, 91, 92 and 101 of the Traffic Act 2005 and all other enabling powers, the Government has made the following Regulations—

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Parking and Waiting) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2017.

Commencement.

2. These Regulations come into operation on the day of publication.

Amendment to the Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Regulations 2011.

- 3.(1) The Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Regulations 2011 are amended in accordance with this regulation.
- (2) In regulation 3(13), for "during the hours" substitute "and in accordance with any conditions or restrictions".
- (3) After regulation 3, insert-

"Loading and unloading bays

3A.(1) Loading and unloading bays shall be designated and demarcated by way of yellow paint on the ground or by means of traffic signs prescribed by these regulations or approved by the Minister and erected adjacent to or near the relevant loading and unloading bay.

- (2) The Minister may approve conditions or restrictions for the use of loading and unloading bays and such conditions or restrictions shall be specified in a traffic sign erected adjacent to or near the relevant loading and unloading bay.
- (3) The use of a loading and unloading bay may be restricted to holders of a permit approved by the Minister.".

(4) In Schedule 3-

- (a) in the entry "Issue of parking permit in connection with Zone 1 (fee)", after "Fourth permit per household" insert "After the fourth permit, the fee for every subsequent permit will continue to be twice the fee of the permit it follows"; and
- (b) in the entry "Issue of parking permit in connection with Zone 1 for a person 60 years of age or over (fee)" after "Fourth permit per household for a person 60 years of age or over" insert "After the fourth permit, the fee for every subsequent permit will continue to be twice the fee of the permit it follows".
