TRAFFIC ACT 2005

TRAFFIC (PARKING AND WAITING) (AMENDMENT NO.2) REGULATIONS 2019

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 89, 91, 92 and 101 of the Traffic Act 2005 and all other enabling powers, the Government has made the following Regulations—

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Parking and Waiting) (Amendment No.2) Regulations 2019.

Commencement.

2. These Regulations come into operation on the day of publication.

Amendment to the Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Regulations 2011.

- 3.(1) The Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Regulations 2011 are amended in accordance with this regulation.
- (2) In regulation 5(1), after "in relation to that place" insert ", or by any valid permit permitting that vehicle to park in that place."
 - (3) After regulation 5(1), insert the following-
 - "(1A). In the case of conflict between the period specified on traffic signs and the period specified on a permit permitting the vehicle to park in that place, the period specified on the permit shall prevail."
 - (4) After regulation 41(1), insert the following-
 - "(1A). The holder of a disabled persons badge or institutional badge may park a vehicle in any place requiring a residential parking permit, provided that a disabled persons badge or institutional badge is displayed in the manner set out in regulation 40."
 - (5) After sub-regulation 10(5), insert the following-
 - "(6).A permit which has been issued in respect of one or more registration number plates shall only be valid if displayed in accordance with sub-regulation 3(3A) in

the vehicle which carries the registration number plate expressly stated on the permit.

- (7). No person other than the permit issuing authority shall duplicate a permit."
- (6) In sub-regulations 41(2) and 41(3), after "in a disabled person's bay" insert "or a residential parking place".
 - (7) In regulation 41A–
 - (a) in the title, after "disabled parking bay" insert "or residential parking place"; and
 - (b) in sub-regulation (1) after "disabled parking bay" insert "or a residential parking place".
 - (8) After sub-regulation 41B(1), insert the following-
 - "(1A). No person with a disabled person's badge shall park a vehicle in a residential parking place for any continuous period exceeding the period specified on their permit.".
 - (9) After sub-regulation 62(1), insert the following-
 - "62(1A). A person responsible for any act or omission contrary to regulation 10 is guilty of an offence and punishable on summary conviction to a fine up to level 2 on the standard scale."
 - (10) Substitute the table in Schedule 3 with the following-

- (c) an individual residing at that household holding any of the permits listed in paragraph 5,

the cost of the first permit will be charged at the "Second permit per household" rate and the cost of any subsequent permit will continue from that point as set out in this entry.

- 3. Subject to paragraph 4 in this entry, provided that an applicant meets the requirements for a parking permit, Disabled Persons Badge holders will be eligible for the "First permit per household" to be free of charge.
- 4. Paragraph 3 of this entry will not apply if a household benefits from any of the types of parking spaces, garages or permits listed in paragraph 2.

the cost of the first permit will be charged at the "Second permit per household for a person 60 years of age or over" rate and the cost of any subsequent permit will continue from that point as set out in this entry.	
3. Subject to paragraph 4 in this entry, provided that an applicant meets the requirements for a parking permit, Disabled Persons Badge holders will be eligible for the "First permit per household for a person 60 years of age or over" to be free of charge.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

These Regulations amend the Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Regulations 2011 to provide for parking by disabled badge holders in residential parking spaces.
