TRAFFIC ACT 2005

TRAFFIC (PARKING AND WAITING) (AMENDMENT NO.2) REGULATIONS 2022

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 89, 91, 92 and 101 of the Traffic Act 2005 and all other enabling powers, the Government has made the following Regulations—

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Parking and Waiting) (Amendment No.2) Regulations 2022.

Commencement.

2. These Regulations come into operation on the day of publication.

Amendment to the Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Regulations 2011.

3.(1) The Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Regulations 2011 are amended in accordance with this regulation.

(2) In Schedule 3, substitute the table with the following –

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

These Regulations amend the Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Regulations 2011.
