## TRAFFIC ACT 2005

### TRAFFIC (PARKING AND WAITING) (AMENDMENT NO.3) REGULATIONS 2022

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 89, 91, 92 and 101 of the Traffic Act 2005 and all other enabling powers, the Government has made the following Regulations–

#### **Title.**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Parking and Waiting) (Amendment No.3) Regulations 2022.

#### **Commencement.**

2. These Regulations come into operation on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2022.

#### **Amendment to the Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Regulations 2011.**

3.(1) The Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Regulations 2011 are amended in accordance with this regulation.

(2) In regulation 19–

- (a) renumber regulation 19 “19.(1)”;
- (b) in the newly renumbered subregulation (1), for “Every person” substitute “Subject to subregulation (2), every person”; and
- (c) insert the following after the newly renumbered subregulation (1)–

“(2) Subregulation (1) does not apply where a person has paid the parking fee for a pay and display zone via an online payment portal approved by the Minister.”.

(3) In Schedule 3, substitute the table with the following –

**EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

These Regulations amend the Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Regulations 2011.
