## TRAFFIC ACT 2005

### TRAFFIC (MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2022

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 76, 89, 94A and 94C of the Traffic Act 2005, and all other enabling powers, the Government and the Minister have made the following Regulations-

#### **Title.**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Miscellaneous Amendment) Regulations 2022.

#### **Commencement.**

2. These Regulations come into operation on the day of publication.

#### **Amendment to the Control of Traffic Regulations.**

3.(1) The Control of Traffic Regulations are amended in accordance with this regulation.

(2) After regulation 3 insert-

#### **“Overtaking of bicycles, etc.**

3A.(1) A motor vehicle must not overtake or attempt to overtake a bicycle if to do so would endanger or cause inconvenience to that cyclist.

(2) A motor vehicle must leave a minimum distance of 1.5 metres when overtaking a bicycle.”.

#### **Amendment to the Traffic (Fixed Penalty) Regulations 2011.**

4.(1) The Traffic (Fixed Penalty) Regulations 2011 are amended in accordance with this regulation.

(2) In Schedule 1 after paragraph 1 insert –

“1A.	Overtaking of bicycles etc.	Control of Traffic Regulations	300
	<i>Regulation 8(2) (50% discount) does not apply.</i>	Regulations 3A(1) and (2).	

.”
