**PARKING SCHEME (GLACIS ESTATE ZONE) ESTABLISHMENT  
ORDER 2013**

*In the exercise of the powers conferred on me by regulation 8 of the Traffic (Parking and Waiting) Regulations 2011, and all other enabling powers, I have established a Parking Scheme within the Glacis Estate Zone as set out below-*

Parking facilities in the Glacis Estate Zone are divided into four types:

1. Free motor cycle parking in which anyone can park free of charge within the spaces demarcated “Free Parking Motor Cycles Only”;
2. Car parking spaces demarcated by signposts with the words “Glacis Estate Resident Permit Holders Only” in which only people who live within this Zone and who hold a “Residents’ Parking Permit” issued by Gibraltar Car Parks Ltd may park. This parking is free of charge;
3. Car parking spaces on the top floor of the Devil’s Tower Road multi storey car park in which only people who live within this Zone and who hold a “Residents’ Parking Permit” may park. This parking is free of charge;
4. Car parking spaces demarcated by signposts with the words “Visitors Permit Holders Only” in which only people who do not live within this Zone and who have obtained a “Visitors Permit” from one of the residents of this Zone may park for a maximum duration of one hour between the hours of 8.30am and 9.00pm. This parking is free of charge. Resident Permit Holders may park within these car parking spaces free of charge between the hours of 9.00pm and 8.30am.

A “Residents’ Parking Permit” may be obtained from Gibraltar Car Parks Ltd.

Resident Permit Holders will be issued with:

1. A plastic proximity card that allows them free access to the Residents Only top floor of the Devil’s Tower Road Car Park; and
2. A Visitors Permit for use by bona fide visitors to that Resident Permit Holder.
