**TAXIS (CITY SERVICE AND CRUISE TERMINAL) (AMENDMENT
No. 2) REGULATIONS 2016**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him under section 69 of the Transport Act 1998, and all other enabling powers, the Minister has made the following Regulations-

Title and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Taxis (City Service and Cruise Terminal) (Amendment No.2) Regulations 2016 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

Amendment to Regulations.

2. (1) The Taxis (City Service and Cruise Terminal) Regulations 1999 (“the principal Regulations”) are amended in accordance with the provisions of these Regulations.

Regulation 3.

3. Regulation 3 of the principal Regulations is amended as follows-

- (a) in the tailpiece to subregulation (7) –
 - (i) insert “immediately upon his return to work” after “paragraph (d),”; and
 - (ii) delete “as directed by the Commission”.
- (b) after subregulation (7) insert-
 - “(7A) A driver of a taxi who fails to make up any shortfall pursuant to regulation 3(7) shall-

- (a) remain on city service and be prevented from carrying out a Rock Tour until such time as he makes up for the shortfall for the period equivalent to that missed; and
 - (b) be liable to a fixed penalty pursuant to regulation 67 of the Transport Regulations, and for the avoidance of doubt, payment of the fixed penalty does not exempt a driver from performing the missed city service for which the fixed penalty was issued.
- (7B) Pursuant to the Transport Act, the Commission may revoke or suspend the road service licence of the driver of a taxi who refuses to carry out a city service.”.
