TRANSPORT ACT 1998

TRANSPORT (AMENDMENT) (No.4) REGULATIONS 2016

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 69 of the Transport Act 1998, and all other enabling powers, the Minister has made the following Regulations—

Title and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Transport (Amendment) (No.4) Regulations 2016 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

Amendment of Regulations.

2. The Transport Regulations 2000 (“the principal Regulations”) are amended in accordance with the provisions of these Regulations.

Regulation 67.

3. In regulation 67 of the principal Regulations for subregulations (5)(a) and (b) substitute-

- “(a) to follow the instruction of a Transport Inspector to go to a taxi rank or a different taxi rank to ensure that a sufficient number of taxis are available at specific taxi ranks in order to meet expected demand; and
- (b) to abide by any roster system imposed by the Transport Commission for the purposes of indicating on which days a taxi shall operate a city service.”.

4. After regulation 67(5) of the principal Regulations insert-

- “(6) A person who fails to comply with the provisions of subregulation (5)(b) on more than one occasion shall have the

fixed penalty increased to double the amount of the original fixed penalty.”.

Schedule 3 (Part 1) – Fixed Penalty Offences.

5. In Schedule 3 Part I of the principal Regulations for the entry appearing as regulation 67(5) substitute-

“

67(5)(a)	A taxi driver has failed to follow the instructions of a Transport Inspector to go to a taxi rank or different taxi rank.	100
67(5)(b)	A taxi driver has failed to abide by any roster system imposed by the Transport Commission.	100

”.
