**TRANSPORT ACT 1998**

**TRANSPORT (AMENDMENT NO.2) REGULATIONS 2018**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 69 of the Transport Act 1998, and all other enabling powers, the Minister has made the following Regulations-

**Title.**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Transport (Amendment No.2) Regulations 2018.

**Commencement.**

2. These Regulations come into operation on the day of publication.

**Amendment to the Transport Regulations 2000.**

3.(1) The Transport Regulations 2000 are amended in accordance with this regulation.

(2) In regulation 107-

- (a) in subregulation (1), after “specialist guide licence” insert “and shall be accompanied by a fee of £50 payable to the Board”;
- (b) in subregulation (2)(c), for “at least two European languages” substitute “English”; and
- (c) after subregulation (4), insert-

“(5) In order to be issued with a permit under subregulations (2) or (3), an applicant must pass an examination, set by the Board, on his knowledge of the geography, history and culture of Gibraltar and

his ability to completely guide visitors on one or more of the tours prescribed by the Board.

- (6) An applicant that does not pass an exam set by the Board under subregulation (5) may resit the exam for a fee of £25.”.

- (3) After regulation 107 insert-

“Renewal.

107A. (1) The holder of a licence issued under regulation 107 may renew his licence by applying to the Board for a renewal within a month of the expiry date of the licence.

(2) Subject to subregulation (3), an application made under subregulation (1) must be accompanied by a fee of £20 payable to the Board.

(3) Subregulation (2) does not apply to holders of a road service licence or a road passenger transport operator licence granted under the Transport Act 1998 and applications made under subregulation (1) by holders of these licences must be accompanied by a fee of £10.”
