In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 69 of the Transport Act 1998 the Minister has made the following Regulations—

Title and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Taxi Fares Regulations 2008 and come into operation on 1 September 2008.

Taxi Fares.

2. Taxi fares are as shown in the table below—

	Fare
(i) Flag Down	£2.40
(ii) 1 st unit to 3 rd unit (inclusive)	£0.20 per unit
(iii) 4 th unit to 9 th unit (inclusive)	£ nil per unit
(iv) 10 th unit the fare reaches £9.00	£0.20 per unit
(v) When the fare exceeds £9.00	£0.40 per half unit
Note: each unit comprises 200 metres or 1 minute or a combination of both.

(vii) Saturdays (midday) until Sunday (7 am), Bank and Public Holidays	£0.20
(viii) Sundays	£1.30
(ix) Good Friday, Christmas Day & New Year's Day	£2.00
(x) 24 th and 31 st December as from midday until midnight	£1.30
Additional Charges-	
(a) Each additional passenger after the second (over the age of 6)	£0.50
(b) Luggage per piece (other than hand luggage)	£0.50
(c) Taxi called by telephone	£1.00
(d) Upper Rock (up to 4 passengers)	£10.00
Each additional passenger (over the age of 6) up to the authorised capacity	£1.00
(e) Hiring by time	by agreement between driver & hirer
