In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 69 of the Transport Act 1998 and all other enabling powers, the Minister has made the following Regulations—

Title and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Taxi Fares Regulations 2010 and come into operation on 1 January 2011.

Taxi Fares.

2. Taxi fares are as shown in the table below—

	Fare
(i) Flag Down	£2.40
(ii) 1 st unit to 3 rd unit (inclusive)	£0.20 per unit
(iii) 4 th unit to 9 th unit (inclusive)	£ nil per unit
(iv) 10 th unit the fare reaches £8.00	£0.20 per unit
(v) When the fare exceeds £8.00	£0.40 per unit
Note: each unit comprises 200 metres or 1 minute or a combination of both.	
Automatically included in flag down	
(vi) Midnight to 7.00 am	£1.30
(vii) Saturdays (7am to midnight)	£0.60
(viii) Saturday and Sunday (midnight to 7am)	£1.50
(ix) Sundays (after 7am and including Public Holidays)	£1.30
(x) Good Friday, Christmas Day & New Year's Day (7am till	£2.00
